



# 2010 Kidz Create • Summer Art Program

All classes will be held at the Art Center. We are located west of Miles City on Waterplant Road. Multi-day classes or “camps” need to be attended in full to ensure completion of projects. Please note required materials. Pre-registration is required for each class. Space is limited. Our summer hours are Tuesday through Sunday 9am to 5pm. Most classes are open to kids 7 years of age and up. Art Center staff will instruct classes unless otherwise noted.

## MULTIPLE DAY ART CLASSES

### Clay Camp

Tuesday June 8th through Friday June 11th

Ages 7 and up, 1:30-4:00pm, \$40/\$45

and Saturday June 19th, 10:00am-Noon (glaze day)

Let's play in the mud and make some great art projects! Participants will throw, coil and slab-build several one-of-a-kind clay pieces. Instruction will focus on textures, pattern, form and hand-eye coordination.

### Silk Screening

Tuesday June 15th through Friday June 18th

Ages 7 and up, 10:00am-Noon, \$20/\$25

Using stencil and wax techniques, participants will make their own 2D designs. Participants will need to provide their own T-shirt's. Any other materials that you wish to print on are welcome.

### Kite Construction

Tuesday June 15th through Friday June 18th

Ages 7 and up, 2:00-4:00pm, \$20/\$25

Come and engineer your own kite and learn about the long history of kites: warfare, religious rituals, aid to flight and much more. Participants will draw plans, construct kites and fly them - wind permitting.

### Mosaic Mania

Wednesday June 23rd through Friday June 25th

Ages 7 and up, 2:00-4:30pm, \$18/\$23

Participants will learn the process of designing and installing patterns using bits of pottery, glass, marbles, shells, and stone. We will make 2 mosaics; using a reverse plaster mold making approach and a positive grout application approach.

### Painting & Drawing Camp

Tuesday June 29th through Friday July 2nd

Ages 7 and up, 1:30-4:00pm, \$20/\$25

Participants in this class will experiment with pencil, charcoal, ink, and acrylic paint. Starting with basic techniques, students will progress using value, scale and their own subject matter.

### Little Kidz Art Camp

Tuesday July 6th through Friday July 9th

Ages 5-6, 9:30am-Noon, \$25/\$30

Participants in this class will experience all of the “big” kid classes but on a small scale. Sand painting, ceramic wall tiles, bark paintings, concrete stepping stones, paper cutting and drawing.

### Kinetic Art Camp

Wednesday July 14th through Friday July 16th

Ages 7 and up, 10:00am-Noon, \$18/\$23

For those who like to build things, this class is for you. Participants in this class will build wire, tissue and bead sculptures. Learning about movement, balance and implied line, these sculptures will really move.

### Papermaking

Wednesday July 21st through Friday July 23rd

Ages 7 and up, 10:00am-Noon, \$18/\$23

Bring any special paper, ribbon, or dried flowers to put in your paper

Learn to reuse discarded paper to make new, unique paper great for making cards, journals, or decorative paper. Using a blender, participants will make a fresh pulp from old paper.

## MULTIPLE DAY ART CLASSES

(CONT.)

### Pinhole Photography

Wednesday July 21st and Thursday July 22nd

Ages 7 and up, 2:00-4:00pm, \$14/\$16

Participants will construct their very own camera out of a box, oatmeal can, or tin. This class will cover the mechanics of photography by taking and developing their own pictures.

### Dioramas

Wednesday July 28th through Friday July 30th

Ages 7 and up, 2:00-4:30pm, \$18/\$23

*Bring any found or reusable items that can be cut, glued and/or painted on*

Much like a shadow box, participants in this class will create a scene in cardboard, wood or tin container. After developing a narrative, participants will cut, draw, glue and paint their way to a diorama.

### Exhibit Explorer: "Threads"

Tuesday August 3rd through Wednesday August 4th

Ages 7 and up, 10:00am-Noon, \$10/\$12

Participants in this class will view and study the "Threads" exhibit. Art works will include the mediums of glass, metal, and fibers. Using pencil and paint, participants will sketch the artworks; incorporating their own ideas into their works on paper

### Wild Watercolor

Wednesday August 4th through Thursday August 5th

Ages 7 and up, 2:00-4:00pm, \$10/\$12

Explore the many techniques of watercolor; the transparent medium. Go crazy with bold colors and splashy forms and integrate new skills and knowledge of composition. Participants will work from nature and still life.

### Mask Making

Wednesday August 11th through Friday August 13th

Ages 7 and up, 10:00am-Noon, \$18/\$23

Participants will learn to make paper mache/cardboard and ceramic masks. Both functional and nonfunctional masks will be constructed during this workshop. Let the wild side come out; these masks are very eclectic!

### Clay Whistles

Thursday August 12th through Friday August 13th

Ages 7 and up, 2:00-4:00pm, \$14/\$16

*and Saturday August 21st at 10:00am (pickup and play)*

Known as the Ocarina in Chinese and Mesoamerican cultures. Participants will learn how to make a clay whistle that really makes music! The first 2 days will be spent constructing and designing their whistles. Participants will return the following Saturday to pickup and play their instruments.

## ONE DAY ART CLASSES

### Concrete Stepping Stones (3 separate offerings)

Thursday June 10th or Wednesday June 30th  
or Thursday August 5th

Ages 7 and up, 10:00am-Noon, \$10/\$12

Diamonds in the Rough! Participants will arrange bits of glass and pottery into colorful mosaic patterns. These shards will be embedded in a cement tile that can be used in the garden or patio.

### Clay Birds & Birdhouses

Wednesday July 7th, Ages 7 and up, 2:00-4:30pm, \$10/\$12

*pickup will be Friday, July 16th @ 2:00pm*

Participants in this class will construct a clay birdhouse and a clay bird to go in it. Using pinch pot and slab-building techniques these small sculptures will be completed in one session. Glazing will take place during class.

### Origami

Wednesday July 14th, Ages 7 and up, 2:00-4:00pm, \$8/\$10

Learn to make beautiful flowers and animals out of folded paper during this popular class. Participants will learn to make frogs, birds, flowers, and ships out of brightly patterned paper.

### Rainsticks

Tuesday August 3rd, Ages 7 and up, 2:00-4:00pm, \$8/\$10

Transform an ordinary tube into a magical, musical instrument that imitates the sound of a rainstorm. We will decorate the instruments with bits of clay, stone and wood.

## ADULT CLAY CLASS

7-Week Session

"Clay Prospecting & Outdoor Raku Fire"

Wednesday Nights, June 16th through July 28th

6:30-9:30pm, \$75/\$80

This class is open to both beginning & advanced participants. As part of the "summer fun" participants will go on a clay hunt and use that clay in an outdoor firing. Basic wheel throwing techniques will be covered during class time. The clay hunt will be June 30th and the outdoor firing will be July 28th.

## HIGH SCHOOL CLAY CLASS

7-Week Session

Thursday Nights, June 17th through July 29th

6:00-8:00pm, \$65/\$70

Participants in this class will hand-build and wheel-throw several forms. We will fire the pots in both the Raku kiln and the Hi-Fire kiln. Handles, form, and proportion will be the focuses of this class.
